Product range

The investigation into the cause of possible cracking in the **QSA Plug-in unit 160 A** has been extended to **QSA 250 - 630 A Plug-in units and all other Eaton Plug-in units**. This applies to the following product range:









The conclusion of this study led to the following overall measure, namely:



All Plug-in units may not be removed in an energized condition!

Above measure applies to installed Plug-in units as well as to the new Plug-in units.

Solution and instructions

For the already installed Plug-in units we offer the following solution and instructions:

QSA 160 A

Plug-in unit

- 1. Fixation of the already installed Plug-in units by installing reinforcement brackets.
- 2. If fixation is not possible by using reinforcement brackets, the Plug-in units need to be replaced.



For the replacement Eaton will make you a customized offer.

After above mentioned modifications the Plug-in units can be operated normally, **but not removed in energized condition.**

Further research has shown that these Plug-in units can be operated normally, **but not removed in energized condition**.

Instruction stickers

Enclosed you find instruction stickers that you have to place on the outside of your low-voltage installation immediately in the proximity of the main switch.
